destination. MIDIGAMA

Midigama is a small, laid-back coastal village on Sri Lanka's south coast, positioned between Ahangama and Weligama.

Best known for its **surf**, uncrowded stretches of coastline and slower pace of life, it offers a quieter alternative to the south coast's larger beach towns while remaining within easy reach of its restaurants, cafés, beaches and attractions.

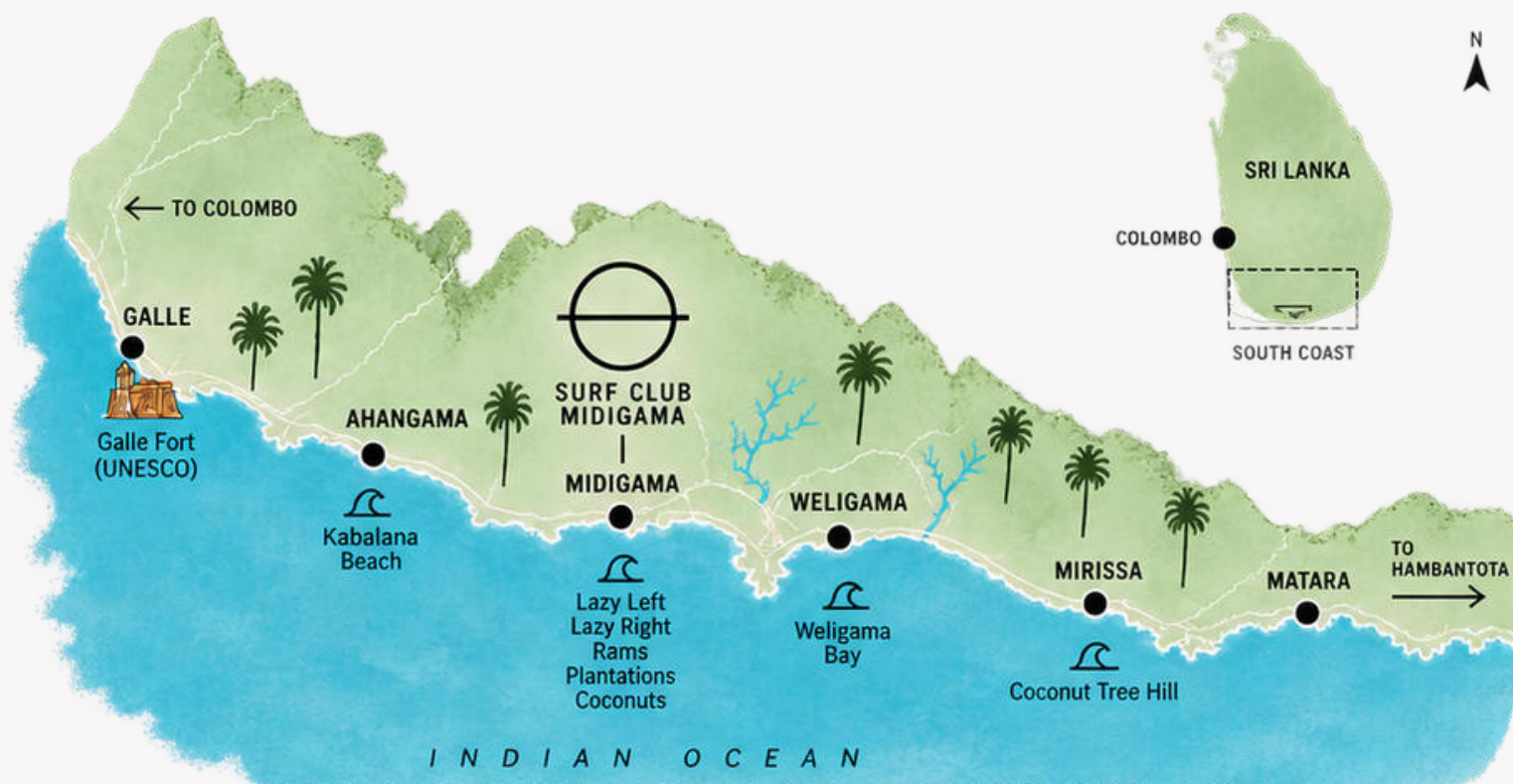
The coastline around Midigama is home to some of Sri Lanka's best-known surf breaks, including **Lazy Left**, Lazy Right, Rams, Plantations and Coconuts, catering to a range of abilities from progressing surfers through to experienced riders. Weligama Bay, a short drive away, offers gentler conditions particularly well suited to beginners. Surf Club Midigama and Chalets Midigama sit on 120 metres of beachfront with the Lazy Left surf break directly out front - the perfect base to explore the south coast.

THE SOUTH COAST

To the east of Midigama, **Weligama** and **Mirissa** bring a broader mix of restaurants, cafés, beaches and whale-watching experiences, while **Ahangama** lies in the opposite direction along the coast. Further west, the UNESCO-listed **Galle Fort** makes an easy half-day or day trip for its historic streets, shops, galleries and restaurants.

Midigama therefore works particularly well as a base for guests wanting to experience the south coast without staying in its busier centres - with surf and the ocean on the doorstep, and the wider coast within easy reach.

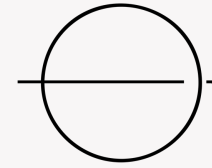

Surf Club Midigama is our take on **A Seaside Way of Life** - 120 metres of Midigama Beach, with the Lazy Left surf break directly out front, and everything a guest needs nestled within our ecosystem.

The Beach Club anchors the property: a restaurant, bar and coffee counter, pool with floating sunbeds, and day beds on the sand - open from morning coffee until late.

The kitchen serves our take on **Seaside Cuisine** - Sri Lankan produce and coastal techniques (curing, fermenting, grilling, pickling) built around local fish, vegetables, coconut, spice and rice, with influences from the Mediterranean, Middle East and Asia.

The bar offers a curated selection of **craft cocktails** paying homage to local ingredients, alongside some of the best coffee and matcha on the island.

Music runs from open to close, with DJs and live musicians from the south coast, Colombo and beyond brought in for curated events and programming on selected nights.

Along the beach sit the **Chalets** - five pastel two-storey buildings of Deluxe and Premier rooms, every one sea-facing with direct access to the beach, plus a Club Premier on the top floor of the Beach Club.

The upstairs **Living Room** and **The Terrace** area (opening soon) offer beautiful intimate and open plan spaces overlooking the pool club and ocean, suitable for private dinners, events and pop-ups for groups of up to 150.

A **surf school**, by international luxury surf aggregator Perfect Wave, is coming soon.



eat. *SEASIDE CUISINE*

The food at Surf Club Midigama is our take on Seaside Cuisine - created for a relaxed, all-day way of life by the ocean.

From all-day breakfast to the Beach Club menu and a more elevated Club menu from lunch onwards, the kitchen is built predominantly around Sri Lankan seafood and produce: local fish, coconut, citrus, green chilli, tropical fruit, rice, vegetables and island spices.

Expect everything from cured fish, ceviche and sashimi to green chilli prawns, grilled and braised octopus, yellowfin tuna, burnt baby squid, whole fish, crab and clam pasta, and generous larger plates designed for sharing around the table.

It is fresh, produce-led and unmistakably coastal - Sri Lankan at its heart, with a wider world of seaside influences.

relax. *THE CLUB HOUSE*

The Club House is contemporary in design, with layers of pink cut-cement walls, distressed timber columns, glass ceilings, rattan ceilings, planting and artwork inspired by the beach, surf and daily life in Midigama.

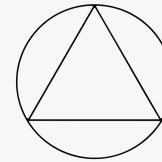
The spaces have the familiar feel of a traditional club house by the beach: tables in the shade, bar seating, day beds and the sand directly ahead. Furniture is a mix of simple, functional pieces and stronger feature pieces: timber tables, lounge chairs, woven stools, day beds, sunbeds and bar seating.

The spaces are designed to be comfortable for a long stay. Thoughtfully delivered by renowned local architects, A Design Studio, the overall concept and product design are by Cantaloupe & Co.

Chalets Midigama is Surf Club Midigama's boutique hotel - five pastel-coloured, two-storey chalets set directly on the beach, and a Club Premier on the top floor of the Beach Club. Every room is sea-facing with easy access to the pool and Beach Club. We will have four more Chalets opening very soon.

Inside, the design language is warm and understated: solid timber, contemporary tropical furniture, teak wooden floors, woven natural materials, subway tiles, crisp white linen and brass, and carefully selected decor and interior design touches - designed for a comfortable stay akin to *A Seaside Way of Life*.

Each of our 5 duplex chalets holds a 30 sqm Deluxe Chalet on the ground floor and a 30 sqm Premier Chalet above it. Every room comes with a king-size bed dressed in 400 thread-count linen, air-conditioning, Wi-Fi, a minibar, safe, coffee table and study desk. Bathrooms are fitted with twin vanities, rain and hand showers, teak-framed mirrors, brass fittings and bathrobes, with amenities made from natural local fruit extracts.

The Club Premier (35 sqm) sits on the first floor of the Club House, opening directly into the Living Room space. It's the largest room in the collection - extra spacious, with a private balcony overlooking the pool and ocean, and views over the Club House area below. The room is finished with handmade Moroccan zellige tiles, each one individually cut with its own shifts in colour, glaze and edge, alongside twin vanities, rain and hand showers, teak-framed mirrors and brass fittings. Like every chalet, it comes with a king-size bed dressed in 400 thread-count linen, air-conditioning, Wi-Fi, minibar, safe, coffee table and study desk.

The Club House pool measures 18.6m long × 4.3m wide × 1.2m deep and is lined with pearl-white hexagonal tiles. Their pearlescent finish gives the water its signature cobalt-blue colour.

In front of the Chalets, shaded canopies lead through natural flora towards the beach, with both the Chalets and Club House boasting unparalleled direct beach access.

Midigama beach is directly accessible from both the chalets and the Club House. The natural reef makes the water ideal for swimming during the season, while a natural rockpool can be enjoyed year round. Sunbeds are set along 120 metres of fine, white sand.

The infamous Lazy Left surf break is located directly in front of Surf Club. It is one of Sri Lanka's best-known surf breaks and has brought surfers from all over the world to Midigama for many years. Our soon to open Surf School, operated by luxury surf operator, Perfect Wave, will be running surf lessons and packages throughout the season.

Days and evenings at Midigama can be as active or as slow as our guests like.

Surf the breaks directly out front, start the morning with yoga or Pilates, or slow things down with a massage or sound healing.
